Subject: Reminder- Info asked regarding Promotion from JTO(T) to SDE(T) in 67% Seniority-cum-Fitness quota

Dear Sir,

It is very disappointing to say the least that Circle Office has not yet supplied the complete information asked for vide above mentioned reference letter dated more than a month back. The information is crucial as it can affect the carrier progression of many executives. So far, circle gradation lists of JTOs are given on the Punjab Intranet which are not even complete with relative seniority of Internal(Deptt) vis-à-vis External(Direct Recrtd) in cadre of JTO(T).

I once again request you to personally look into the matter so that the said information can be supplied to the stakeholders in time-bound manner.

I would also like to invite your kind attention towards the reference orders issued by the corporate office (annexed) regarding the fixation relative seniority of Internal(Deptt) vis-à-vis External(Direct Recrtd) in cadre of JTO(T). It has been observed from the intranet that now BSNL Corporate office is requesting all the circles to forward the eligibility list of JTO(T) for promotion to SDE(T) in 67% Seniority-cum-Fitness quota.

Moreover, the vacancy particulars of JTO(T) cadre (i.e. Total vacancies further divided to 50% External (Direct Recrtd) and 50% of Internal (Deptt) cadre from the year the candidates are considered for the promotion on seniority cum fitness to verify vacancy position for the each year.

I request you to provide a real & fair opportunity to this association to verify the gradation list of the eligible candidates of JTO(T) from Punjab circle to confirm whether the above mentioned reference orders of Department of Personnel & Training, Govt of India further endorsed by BSNL Corporate Office are actually followed in true spirit.
